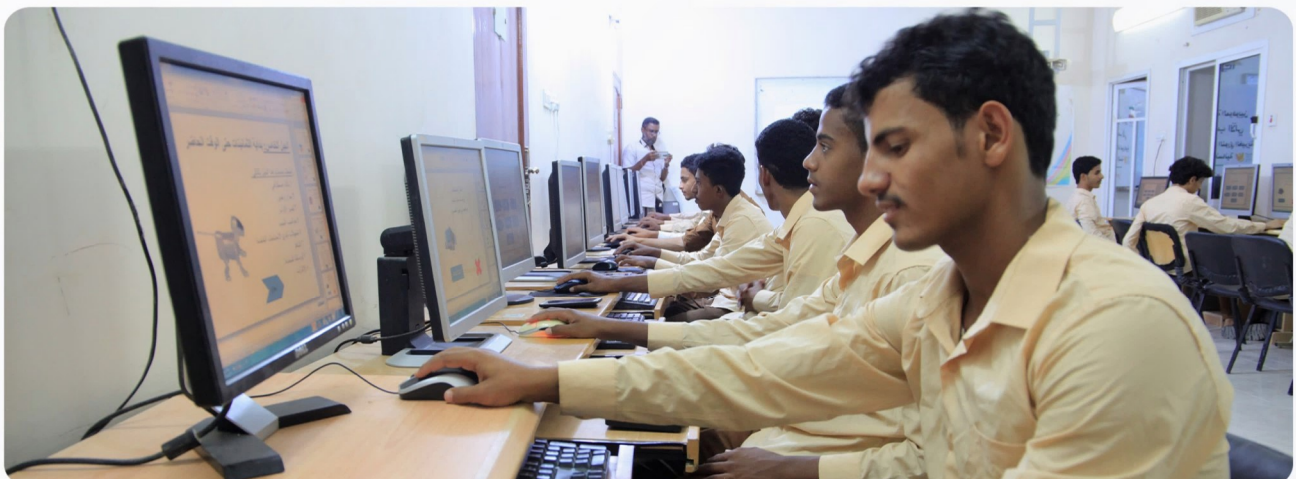

Health Field

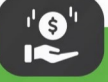
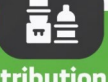
