Yemen and the challenge of survival

Millions of people in Yemen are suffering from the devastating effects of war, the ongoing economic crisis and the disruption of public services. The escalating conflict has led to the collapse of the economy - which is one of the outcomes of the conflict - and has resulted in an exacerbation of vulnerability among poor families, more than 23.4 million people - nearly three-quarters of the population - in need of humanitarian aid and protection.

The plight of Yemenis indeed remains bleak as limited access to vital services continues to exacerbate the conditions of the most vulnerable groups, most of whom are women and children.

The United Nations announced that Yemen is the fourth country in the world in the number of internally displaced people, which exceeds 4 million due to the conflict that has been ongoing for years. The United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees said, in a recent report, that in Yemen "there is the fourth largest number of internally displaced people due to conflict in the world," and their number is estimated at about 4.3 million displaced people, in addition to 97,018 refugees and asylum seekers.

Reports indicated that Yemen remains one of the largest humanitarian crises in the world. After many years of devastating conflict, about 23.4 million Yemenis (73% of the total population) relay on humanitarian aid to survive.

The displaced in Yemen suffer from both things, and the situation is not much different for the local host communities, as everyone suffers from a lack of services such as water, schools, and sanitation... in addition to the lack of food and drink. With the United Nations reducing in-kind assistance to millions of them, their suffering has increased, especially with prices have increased by more than 300% since the beginning of the war.

In Yemen, faith and wisdom, the long years of war affected millions of people. Suffering, poverty, destitution, and need have become a dominant feature of life inside. There is no sufficient income, no housing to shelter, children without a childhood, and women without help. These are the results of seven years of war and fighting. All of these factors have motivated those interested in humanitarian and service side . institutions, associations and organizations at the local, regional and international to place Yemen within their programmatic humanitarian maps, and from this point Albadyh interventions, programs and projects come which is covered in this guide, and we extend our hands to all organizations and good people to work together in order to achieve a decent living for our communities and achieve our noble humanitarian goals.




